

Paris Annual Conference of Experimental Sociology

**Preliminary programme  
18 May 2026**

The basic template of the proposed programme is two half days at the beginning and end plus a full day in the middle.

In this template, each conference session is 90 minutes long. Each session involves 4 speakers. Each speaker has 20 net minutes to present their work (going by the usual allotment of 15 minutes for the monologue and 5 minutes for Q&A). The remaining 10 minutes are usually consumed in transitions, various delays, etc.

With this schedule, we offer slots to 80 speakers.

There are at present 83 acceptees. It is unlikely that all 83 acceptees will first register and then come to Paris.
